Ministry Role

Each Cultivate participant will choose an area of ministry and a role. In the context of purposeful ministry, the individual will gain experience, skills, training and development. The average ministry role will be 3-5 hours per week.

Ministry Mentor

Each Cultivate participant will be paired up with a person who has experience in the area of Ministry chosen. The Ministry Mentor will usually be a staff member or elder. The Cultivate participant will meet with their Ministry Mentor every other week for about an hour or more as needed. The role of the Ministry Mentor is to give guidance, training, and feedback in the defined area of ministry.

Cultivate Coach

Each Cultivate participant will be paired up with a Cultivate Coach. The Cultivate participant will meet with their Cultivate Coach every other week for about an hour. The role of a Cultivate Coach is to ask questions, listen and pray for the individual. Cultivate Coaches have received training and support for this important role.

Equipping

Cultivate participants will receive equipping in a variety of ways.

Much of the equipping will be specific to the area of ministry.

Some of the equipping will be recommendations toward classes, books or podcasts. There will be 3 all day Saturday sessions that will be required equipping times for Cultivate participants.
